At the click of a button there are library services available to you right around the clock

- **Click and collect** – you go online, request a book, audiobook or DVD and we let you know when it is ready for you to collect
- **Click and discover** – a wide range of information at your fingertips to help with homework, research or general interest.
- **Click and read** – eBooks that you download from our website to read
- **Click and listen** – eAudiobooks that you download from our website to listen to.

## Join the library and then click away...the Derbyshire library service at your fingertips!

You need to be a member of Derbyshire libraries to use the following services. Membership is open to anyone living, working or studying in Derbyshire. It is easy and free to join in person or online.

To join in person call into your local library with some form of identification with your name and address on it. Children are never too young to join the library.

### Click and collect

We have thousands of books, audiobooks and DVDs available for loan. If there is something you want to borrow we will do our very best to get it and then we will deliver it to the Derbyshire library of your choice for you to collect.

You may have a specific book, audiobook or DVD in mind to borrow or you may be looking for inspiration. You choose which Derbyshire library you want to collect it from. We will ring, email or text you when the item is ready and waiting for you.



### Click and discover

Need information now? Use our information service to find the answers to your questions. All of our library members have FREE access from their home computer to a wide range of high quality information. There is something for all the family from help with homework, to passing your driving test, to solving that last crossword clue. Plus there's more online information in our libraries including help with starting your family tree.

### Click and read – eBooks

Carry the library in your pocket – you can fill up your mobile device with books from our eBooks library.

Visit the eBooks section of our website – [www.derbyshire.gov.uk/ebooks](http://www.derbyshire.gov.uk/ebooks) – browse the catalogue and choose the title that you want to borrow – you can borrow up to five eBooks for up to 21 days. You are then guided through easy steps to 'checkout' your eBook and download it.

At the end of the loan period the eBook(s) will be deleted automatically from your device, so there are no overdue fines to worry about. If the book you want is already checked out you can reserve it free of charge and you will receive an alert when it is available for you to download.



### Click and listen – eAudiobooks

Whilst eBooks are the ones that you download and read eAudiobooks are ones that you download and listen to. We have over 1,000 unabridged titles for you to choose from at [www.derbyshire.gov.uk/ebooks](http://www.derbyshire.gov.uk/ebooks)

Having made your choice you download the eAudiobook directly onto your mobile phone, tablet or MP3 player.

Clear instructions guide you through the process and once signed up you can borrow eAudiobooks wherever you are in the world, twenty four hours a day, seven days a week.

You can borrow up to five eAudiobooks at a time for up to 21 days. After 21 days the eAudiobooks file will expire. They can be renewed or returned and there are no overdue charges to worry about. eAudiobooks have a host of features that may prove useful. For instance it is possible to slow down the speed at which the book is being read out to the listener.
